

## Expanded local calling comes to the Northshore

We have good news to announce! Calls between communities in the three Northshore parishes of St. Tammany, Tangipahoa and Washington will become toll free effective April 10, 2007, thanks to action taken by Commissioner Jay Blossman and the Louisiana Public Service Commission.

Once the local calling areas for these communities are expanded, AT&T Louisiana customers with flat-rate service will no longer have to pay toll or usage charges for calls between the 19 communities listed below:

St. Tammany: Bush, Covington, Folsom, Lacombe, Madisonville, Mandeville, Pearl River and Slidell

Tangipahoa: Amite, Hammond, Independence, Kentwood and Ponchatoula

Washington: Angie, Bogalusa (including Crossroads, MS), Franklinton, Mt. Hermon and Pine

Beginning April 10, all calls between these Northshore communities must be dialed on a seven-digit basis; local calls to communities in a different area code (including calls to and from Crossroads, MS) must be dialed on a 10-digit basis (area code + seven-digit number).

The new calling points will be included in these plans; calls to Crossroads, MS, must be dialed on a 10-digit basis (601 + seven-digit number).
