Chairman Clyde Holloway Passes Away

Baton Rouge – The state of Louisiana has lost a dedicated public servant. Commission Chairman Clyde Holloway passed away at the age of 72 Sunday evening at his home in Forest Hill.

Holloway had served on the Public Service Commission since 2009. Prior to that office, he was the Louisiana State Director of Rural Development for the U. S. Department of Agriculture under President George W. Bush. Holloway was elected to Congress in 1986 and served from 1987-1993, until Louisiana lost the Eighth Congressional District in redistricting due to the 1990 Census.

He owned and operated Holloway's Nursery in his hometown of Forest Hill, a business he started with his wife in the early 1970s. Holloway is survived by his wife of 50 years, Cathie, his four children, nine grandchildren and six siblings.

Funeral arrangements are pending.
