MINUTES OF JANUARY 14, 2026 OPEN SESSION OF THE LOUISIANA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION HELD IN BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA. PRESENT WERE CHAIRMAN ERIC SKRMETTA, VICE CHAIRMAN JEAN-PAUL COUSSAN, COMMISSIONER FOSTER CAMPBELL, COMMISSIONER MIKE FRANCIS, COMMISSIONER DAVANTE LEWIS, AND EXECUTIVE SECRETARY BRANDON FREY.

Open Session of January 14, 2026, convening at 9:18 a.m., and adjourning at 9:48 a.m., at the Galvez Building, 602 N. 5th Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, with the above-name members of the Commission and Executive Secretary Brandon Frey present.

Ex. 1	Chairman Skrmetta welcomed Chris Martel, new director of regulatory affairs at SWEPCO. Commissioner Lewis congratulated Helena Moreno for being sworn in as the 63 rd Mayor of New Orleans and gave well wishes to the new members of the New Orleans City Council, especially members of the Utilities Committee. He also requested that the CEO of Delta Utilities come before the Commission at the February meeting for an update and report on operations. Vice Chairman Coussan also congratulated the New Orleans City Council members and the Mayor of New Orleans. He thanked Commissioner Francis for his service as the Commission's Chairman for 2025 and being a great mentor for his first year serving on the Commission.
