Crews continue restoration efforts with full restoration expected tomorrow

PINEVILLE, La. – Sept. 13, 2024 (3 p.m.) – Cleco continues power restoration efforts to the remaining 3,050 customers who lost power due to Hurricane Francine. The company expects most customers will have power by end of day today, Sept. 13, and the remaining customers on Saturday, Sept. 14.
